## Profile

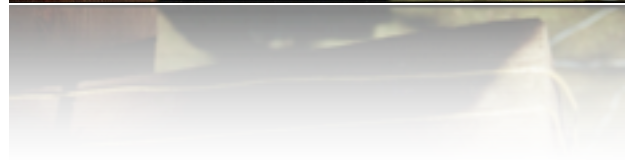
Pete Hamilton is an emerging British artist with a background in digital image, film and new media, including the web; specialising in digital processes and investigations of place.
